PT Astra Agro Lestari Tbk ("the Company") in January 2023 has produced 330 thousand tons of Fresh Fruit Bunches (FFB), or an increase of 19.5% compared to January 2022. This increase was in line with the 24.6% increase in nucleus FFB production in January 2023.

The Company also produced 93 thousand tons of Crude Palm Oil (CPO) as of January 2023, which decreased by 0.5% compared to January 2022. This was in line with the decrease in Kernel production by 8.9% to 19 thousand tons in January 2023 compared to January 2022 of 21 thousand tons.

As of 2022, Astra Agro recorded a 10.3% decrease in net income to Rp 22 trillion. In 2022, the Company already paid export levies and export taxes of Rp 925 billion or decreased by 306% YTD in 2021, which is Rp 228 billion. Until 2022, the Company also recorded an increase for average selling price CPO to 14,6% compared to the same period the previous year. Net profit attributable to

shareholders in September 2022 was IDR 1.7 trillion, a decrease of 12.4% compared to the previous year.



### SUSTAINABILITY ASPIRATION

#### **Public Contribution**



Empowerment of smallholders group program has embraced  $\pm$  **53,700** smallholders in the supply chain and can drive economic growth in more than **400** villages.

Through the Astra Prosperous Village (Desa Sejahtera Astra/DSA) program designs the roles of local groups or communities and their cadres through a series of type of businesses with coaching support. The DSA program have an impact on 92 company zone one villages with total of 153 Forest Local Communities who have various backgrounds.





The Company provide access to advanced training for fostered MSMEs that have consistently profited from MSMEs program can collaborate with Astra International. In total, there were **11 fostered MSMEs** joined the training online from June to August 2022.

The Company also supports various government programs that are packaged in the Posyandu-based **Community Health Activity Center (PK2M)**. Various PK2M activities include mentoring, education, and providing infrastructure assistance to **331 Posyandu** located in zone one villages in the Company's operational area.





The Company has provided assistance in the form of PMT (Supplementary Feeding), vitamins for **3,341 pregnant women**, **17,924 infants and toddlers**.

Astra Agro has managed **60 schools** with total **23,558 children** from various levels of education consisting **37 kindergartens**, **13 elementary schools**, and **10 junior high school** with employs **500 teachers** who are permanent employees.





The Company is also developing a character-based literacy education program through the implementation of the Child Friendly School program targeted **1,934 teachers** and **28,790 parents** in **194 assisted schools** from kindergarten to senior high school/equivalent which impacted **28,827 students**.



# **SUSTAINABILITY ASPIRATION**

### **Public Contribution**



The Company distributed Astra Education scholarships to 2,220 community children attending the assisted School.

There were 13 schools and one Wisma Madu Rimbo dedicated to facilitating the children of the Orang Rimba community with a total of 421 students.





Seven posyandu units have been established to serve 313 Orang Rimba families, including 151 babies and toddlers and 18 mothers.
