Progress Update on Independent Third Party Verification

EcoNusantara (ENS) began the on-the-ground process in Sulawesi on May 22nd, 2023 with two

days of fact-finding in Palu.

We understand that WALHI has rejected the notion of further investigation. While we respect

WALHI's position, ENS had planned to communicate with WALHI at a pre-arranged kick off

meeting on May 25th, 2023 in Palu for consultation with two objectives, namely: (a) building a

common understanding of stakeholders on the comprehensive verification agenda to be carried out

within the next 3 months, and (b) to build effective communication during the verification process.

However, at the last minute, Walhi decided it felt unable to join. ENS deeply regrets that this

happened, since the objectives (a) and (b) above may not now be optimally achieved, and this

causes us concern that the verification process would potentially be hampered, which ultimately

could make the conflict resolution process lengthy and detrimental to the comfort and safety of the

community.

Nevertheless, field visits will commence on May 26th, 2023 to affected communities within the

sites of PT Lestari Tani Teladan, PT Agro Nusa Abadi, and PT Mamuang, followed by needs

assessments in Toviora village. ENS will provide a progress report on June 7th, 2023. The rest of

June is blocked off for field visits and village needs assessments, and bi-weekly updates to

stakeholders will be released regularly.
