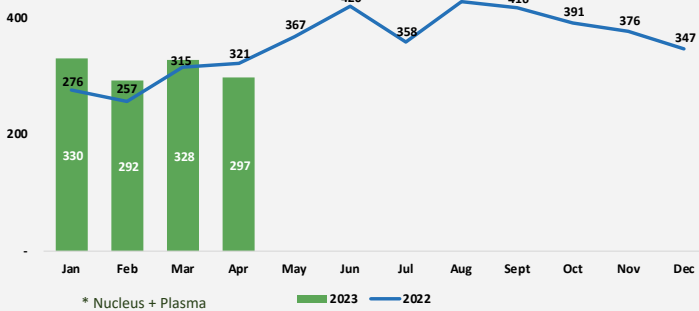

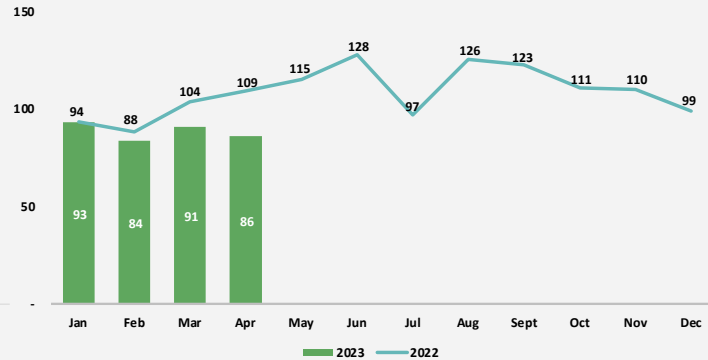
PT Astra Agro Lestari Tbk ("the Company") as of April 2023 has produced 1,2 million tons of Fresh Fruit Bunches (FFB), or an increase of 6.5% compared to April 2022. This increase was in line with the 8.0% increase in nucleus FFB production as of April 2023 compared to the same period in 2022.

The Company also produced 354 thousand tons of Crude Palm Oil (CPO) as of April 2023, which decreased by 10.4% compared to April 2022. This was in line with the decrease in Kernel production by 16.2% to 73 thousand tons as of April 2023 compared to April 2022 of 87 thousand tons.

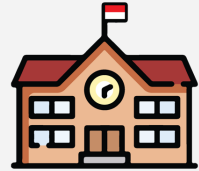

The Company recorded a 27.7% decrease in net revenue from Rp 6.6 trillion in March 2022 to Rp 4.8 trillion in March 2023. This was due to a 19.3% decrease in the Company's average CPO price and a 53.1% decrease in the average Kernel price as of March 2023 compared to March 2022. The decrease resulted in a 53.5% decrease in profit attributable to owners of the Company from Rp 483 billion as of March 2022 to Rp 225 billion as of March 2023.

Public Contribution

Astra Agro has managed **194 schools** with total **28.827 student** from various levels of education and **1934 teachers** who are permanent employees located in company's operational area.



ORANG RIMBA PROGRAM



Astra Agro regularly provided food distribution to the targeted Orang Rimba for **331 families with 1252 people**. The Company has distributed **11.55 tons of rice and 993 food packages** including noodles, sugar, coffee, salt, tea, cooking oil, shampoo, cereal, and soap.

Astra Agro continue to contributes to **give access to education for Orang Rimba group**, both school age children and non-school age children. **with a total of 421 students** (199 students taken non-formal education and 222 students taken formal education)



Astra Agro collaborates with the Director General of Civil Registration, local Population and Civil Registration Service for making **Identity Cards for the Local Community**. As of Quarter 1 2023, there are **785 Orang Rimba residents who already have Identity Cards**.

Astra Agro has provided **knowledge through the agricultural learning center** which is named Suluh Rimbo Sikar and Air Panas. Suluh Rimbo is a program for developing agricultural cultivation to the local community, especially the learning centers for Orang Rimba group
