Response to the Genesis Foundation research report entitled "Astra Agro Lestari

Encroaches on Indonesian Forest Areas," April 2, 2024.

We refer to the article and research report published by the Bengkulu Genesis Foundation on its

website on April 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2024, with the title "Astra Agro Lestari Encroached Forest Areas in

Indonesia."

First of all, we would like to convey that:

(1) PT Astra Agro Lestari (AAL) and its subsidiaries operate in accordance with, and comply

with all applicable laws and regulations in Indonesia.

(2) AAL has a Sustainability Policy established in 2015 and since then, PT AAL has never and

does not have any plan to carry out new land development.

We deeply regret that the Bengkulu Genesis Foundation published the results of research

commissioned by Milieudefensie – Friends of the Earth Netherlands in December 2023 (page 2

footnote of the report) regarding forest encroachment associated with PT AAL's oil palm

plantations using only data available in the public domain, without confirming the origin data

from the company.

We managed to identify the limitations of the data sources utilized in the research, as described

in the research report, which might lead to results that differ significantly from the actual

conditions, including:

1. The Bengkulu Genesis Foundation merely utilized the Nusantara Atlas Map and land

plot maps from Land Affairs and Spatial Planning/National Land Agency (ATR/BPN) as

data sources for the research of deforestation in forest areas accused of PT AAL.

2. The Bengkulu Genesis Foundation also explained that government data regarding the

Rights to Cultivate (HGU) is not public.

Those two illustrations above suggest that the Bengkulu Genesis Foundation does not use HGU

data/location permits for PT AAL subsidiaries, which are legitimately granted by the Indonesian

government. HGU data is very basic material for studying the overlap between forest areas and

HGU/oil palm plantation business permits. Without verified HGU/location permit data, study

results can be misleading.

Indications of the use of data that causing misleading conclusion are described in the following

cases:

(1) Genesis' reference data shows that the plantation area boundaries differ from the shape

of HGU/location permit of PT AAL's subsidiaries.

(2) Genesis' reference data shows that the plantation area analyzed is located in two

different districts from HGU/location permissions of PT AAL subsidiary.

(3) Genesis' reference data shows larger plantation hectarages than HGU/location permits

of PT AAL subsidiaries.

Details of the use of data in the study that can be misleading are described in Appendix 1.

Overlapping Forest Areas (Kawasan Hutan) Versus Palm Oil Plantations Were Mistaken for

**Deforestation** 

We also identified that the Genesis report did not review historical regulations that evolved over

time, especially concerning national spatial planning and its implications for the overlap

between HGU and Forest areas. HGU is a legal product. Cases of overlap between HGU and

Forest Areas interpreted as a form of deforestation in the Genesis Study report can give the

public a misleading perception. The issue of overlapping forest areas and HGU/permits for oil

palm plantations has been regulated in the UUCK (Job Creation Law).

It should be noted that regulatory changes always occur over time. In several cases in

Indonesia, during the regional spatial planning programs, the government repeatedly revised

regulations related to spatial planning as can be seen in Appendix 2.

Based on regulations as in Appendix 2, the Ministry of Forestry and Environment has been redesignating forest estates in stages, which has resulted in numerous cases where parts of the HGU areas were returned to Forest estates, despite the fact that the HGU was secured long before the Decree on the Determination of Forest Estates was published. PT AAL HGU data versus forest area designation can be seen in Appendix 3.

## Replanting activities are mistaken for deforestation

Genesis reports deforestation within forest areas in 15 AAL subsidiary concessions between 2015 and 2023. We clarify that this data is very inaccurate. Since the Sustainability Policy was established in 2015, AAL has never cleared any lands for new development.

## Appendix 2. Development of spatial planning regulation changes:

- 1. Until 1980, based on Forestry Law no. 5 of 1967, forest estates were managed based on registers and partial designation of forest estates.
- 2. From 1980 to 1992, the spatial planning of forest estates was determined through the Forest Use Agreement (TGHK), which was determined by the Minister of Agriculture with strengthening regulations in Law no. 5 of 1990 concerning Conservation of Biological Natural Resources and Their Ecosystems.
- 3. From 1992 to 1999, Law no. 24 of 1992 concerning Spatial Planning. The spatial planning of forest estates is based on the results of the integration between RTRWP and TGHK
- 4. From 1999 to 2005, Law no. 41 of 1999 concerning Forestry, spatial planning of forest estates is based on the designation of forest and water areas determined by the Minister of Forestry.
- 5. From 2005 to 2007, with the issuance of Law no. 32 of 2004, which replaced Law no. 22 of 1999 concerning regional government, spatial planning of forest estates started to have implications due to several provinces and districts/cities proposing revisions to the Provincial Spatial Planning (RTRWP) and District Spatial Planning (RTRWK) as well as the need to use infrastructure with the expansion of government administrative areas.
- 6. From 2007 to today, with the issuance of Law no. 26 of 2007 which replaced Law no. 24 of 1992 concerning Spatial Planning, the spatial planning of forest estates is undergoing adjustments in line with the RTRWP revision process.
- 7. Government Law (PP) No. 26 of 2008 concerning National Regional Spatial Planning (RTRWN), is a guideline for preparing national long-term and national medium-term development plans to realize integration, linkage and balance of development between provincial regions, as well as harmony between sectors, determining the location and function of space for investment, spatial planning of national strategic areas and spatial planning of provincial and district/city areas.
- 8. In 2010, the issuance of PP no. 10/2010 concerning Procedures for Changing the Use and Function of Forest Estates as well as PP 24/2010 concerning the Use of Forest
